The Office for International Studies
at Masaryk University is offering
the CELTA course in Spring 2010

It is open to Czechs, to foreigners with a very good command of English, and to native English speakers; no prior teaching experience is required. Applicants must be at least 20 years of age. The cost of the course is **35,000 Kč**. **MU students may apply for a reduction**, which brings the cost down to **25,000 Kč**. The course will run from 17th February – 28th May 2010, 9 hrs per week (Monday/Tuesday and Wednesday).

- CELTA – recognized **worldwide** by employers in the English Language Teaching industry, Peace Corps, and professional organizations like TESOL and IATEFL (the International Association of Teachers of English as a Foreign Language) – is your passport to professional language teaching employment here and abroad.
Note: The CELTA certificate is a permanent document - that is, its validity is not limited to a fixed period of time.
