The Department of English and American Studies invites applications for a full-time position in the field of English-language translation. Duties will include teaching seminars in non-literary translation (English-Czech), supervising Master's theses in the field of English-language translation and the development of seminars in the field of English-Czech translation. The hiring date is 1 September 2009.

The successful candidate must have at least Master's degree or its equivalent, a minimum of three years experience in the field of translation, a knowledge of general linguistic terminology and translation theory and English-language competence sufficient to teach in English (demonstrable either through a university degree or an internationally-recognized language certificate at the C1 level or higher). Preference will be given to candidates demonstrating extensive experience in the field, a specialization in translating texts from a specific field or area and a doctoral degree or interest in pursuing such a degree.
