13. Professorship procedure of doc. PhDr. Klára Osolobě, Dr. - Czech Language

Course of the procedure: At the beginning of the procedure, the Chair of the Evaluation Board, prof. Kosek, introduced the applicant and summarized the course of the Board's work.

In a lecture entitled *Přegenerování a podgenerování: Jak efektivně vyhledávat v jazykových korpusech data pro lingvistický výzkum*, Associate Professor Osolobě used the case of the DIY type (deverbal person names - appellatives/proprio - formed by converting the "I-ový" participle to the declension type "pán") to show how overgeneration (to increase accuracy) and undergeneration (to maintain coverage) can be adjusted when querying in corpus-based word formation research. Finally, she put the topic in the context of an overview of her own professional scientific profile (works focused on NLP - algorithmization of Czech morphology and word formation, on corpus linguistics - corpus-based analysis as a data source for optimizing automatic analysis of language corpora) and pedagogical activities (use of data driven learning / DDL - inductive approach - drawing conclusions about language functioning based on observation of corpus data, use of language corpora for teaching Czech as a foreign language).

An engaging discussion took place after the lecture, during which doc. Osolsobě answered the questions raised by the Board's and the Scientific Board's members.

Conclusion: the Scientific Board of the FF MU agrees with the proposal to appoint doc. PhDr. Klára Osolsobě, Dr., as a Professor in the field of Czech Language.

14. Habilitation procedure Florin Leonte, PhD - Classical Philology

Course of the procedure: At the beginning of the procedure, the Chair of the Habilitation Board, Prof. Urbanová, introduced the applicant and summarized the course of the Board's work.

In the lecture presented in English entitled "Cross-Cultural Encounters: Greek and Latin Letter-Writing in Late Medieval Eastern Mediterranean", Dr. Leonte focused on the role of letters in the cultural exchange between Byzantine and Italian scholars in the 15th century. This period was marked by significant political changes in the Eastern Mediterranean, especially after the fall of Constantinople to the Ottomans in 1453. The migration of Byzantine scholars to Italy influenced the development of Renaissance humanism. However, the narrative of cultural transfer was more complex than is often portrayed. The Byzantines resisted oversimplified characterizations. The presentation showed that epistolography played a key role in the negotiation of political, ethnic and cultural identity. Letters, written in a friendly language, provided a space for the transmission of knowledge and the creation of a distinct Greco-Roman identity that bridged the gap between East and West.

The lecture was followed by an engaging discussion in which Dr. Leonte answered numerous questions from the Board's members, reviewers and members of the Scientific Board.

Conclusion: the Scientific Board of the FF MU agrees with the proposal to appoint Florin Leonte, PhD, as s Associate Professor in the field of Classical Philology.
