**PAPER SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Papers should be printed in Microsoft Word; 14 Times New Roman, 1,5 interval. Page properties: all margins – 2 cm; schemes, tables and pictures should have titles below them. Initials and family name of the author are printed in semi-bold italics in the upper right corner, 12 Times New Roman; single interval – name of the host university, the country and the city; double interval below in the middle of a page – the title of the paper in capital letters (12 Times New Roman, semi-bold); still double interval below – an abstract, a text and references.

The references in the text are given in square brackets with the name of the author, the year of publication and the page referred to: [Stroykov, 2015: 89]. The list of references is given at the end of the paper in the alphabetical order.
