Performance and Mobility Stipend for Students studying in English Academic Year 2023/2024

The Department of English and American Studies (DEAS) announces the launching of the Performance and Mobility Stipend for Students studying in English. This program further specifies, and operates by, the Provision of the Faculty of Arts of Masaryk University No. 19/2020 Scholarship program to support studies in foreign language study program.

Purpose:

This Performance Stipend is reserved solely for students studying in all B.A. and M.A. programs offered by the DEAS that are accredited in English (fee paying students).

The Mobility Stipend is reserved to all fee-paying students of the DEAS, including the doctoral students.

Its purpose is to motivate students toward better study results and international mobilities.

Round I (autumn 2023)

Eligibility:

The Performance stipend of 2 000 CZK per month for the duration of five months will be paid to B. A. and M. A. students with **an overall grade point average of 1.5 and less** for the autumn semester 2023, who at the same time have not received the grades "F" or "N" or "X" as their final grades in any of their subjects during the period in question.

The Performance stipend of 1 500 CZK per month for the duration of five months will be paid to B.A. and M.A. students with an **overall grade point average of 2.0 to 1,5** for the autumn semester 2023, who at the same time have not received the grades "F" or "N" or "X" as their final grades in any of their subjects during the period in question.

Students participating in an international study or internship stay of the duration of one semester (minimum of three months) can apply for the **Mobility stipend**. A lump sum in the amount of a monthly allowance by the Erasmus program (or by a similar exchange program) will be paid by DEAS, in addition to the Erasmus/other exchange program scholarship. Shorter stays (thirty days up to the three months) may also by supported, but the stipend will be reduced. This stipend is open to all fee-paying students of the DEAS, including doctoral students.

The applicant needs to enter a short text indicating which type of stipend s/he is applying for (Performance stipend or Mobility stipend).

The deadline for submitting applications in this round is March 15, 2024.

For the Performance stipend, the applicant's study advisor will check meeting the conditions as stated above; for the Mobility stipend, the applicant needs to record his/her study stay abroad in his/her study evidence in the Information System in accordance with the norms and documents concerning the study stays abroad.

The Mobility stipend will only be paid following the actual commencement of the international mobility in the student's evidence in the Information System.

Round II (spring 2024)

Eligibility:

The Performance stipend of 2 000 CZK per month for the duration of five months will be paid to B. A. and M. A. students with **an overall grade point average of 1.5 and less** for the spring semester 2024, who at the same time have not received the grades "F" or "N" or "X" as their final grades in any of their subjects during the period in question.

The Performance stipend of 1 500 CZK per month for the duration of five months will be paid to B.A. and M.A. students with an **overall grade point average of 2.0 to 1,5** for the spring semester 2024, who at the same time have not received the grades "F" or "N" or "X" as their final grades in any of their subjects during the period in question.

Students participating in an international study or internship stay of the duration of one semester (minimum of three months) can apply for the **Mobility stipend**. A lump sum in the amount of a monthly allowance by the Erasmus program (or by a similar exchange program) will be paid by DEAS, in addition to the Erasmus/other exchange program scholarship. The Mobility stipend will only be paid following the actual commencement of the international mobility in the student's evidence in the Information System.

Duration:

The program comes into force beginning on March 26, 2021.

Final Provision:

The final decision concerning the awarding of the fellowship rests entirely with the DEAS chair and leadership. The conditions for each semesterly round may be adjusted by the DEAS.
